I was given the agreement signed with the Sheriff's Department on how they will issue and deliver tickets for resident that are in noncompliance with Blight Ordnances in the Township. I reviewed the agreement and will be speaking with the Sheriff's Department as necessary.

I, once again, spoke to the owner about the burnt out trailer and garage on Carpenter Rd. I gave them the estimate that I received and they are suppose to get back to me with when they plan to start. I have told them that it must be started and hopefully removed by April or May or additional actions may be needed. I will call again.

I stopped at a residence on Sand Lake Road and asked the owner to complete the repairs on his car that had been sitting with the front wheels off and non-operable for more than the 24 hours as allowed in the ordnance. The resident finished the repairs and the vehicle and yard are now compliant.

Went to the residence at 5182 Carpenter to speak with the residents there. There was no response and I will be sending a registered letter to this address to get started on getting this property cleaned up and cleared of debris.
