## Cardboard & Mixed Paper

## Containers & Glass

### Cardboard



Corrugated cardboard  
Shipping boxes  
Clean pizza boxes  
Cereal boxes  
Beverage boxes  
Paperboard boxes  
Paper bags

No Styrofoam or film plastic.  
Flatten all cardboard. No  
foam packing material. Tape  
and labels okay.

### Mixed Paper



Office paper  
Junk mail  
Newspapers  
Magazines  
Softcover books  
Hardcover books  
Paper cups  
Cartons  
Paper egg cartons  
Toilet paper rolls  
Shredded paper (must  
be in paper bag)

No gift wrap, napkins,  
laminated paper, or items  
with glitter. Labels are okay.  
Plastic windows on  
envelopes okay.

### Containers



Water & soda bottles  
Milk jugs  
Detergent bottles  
Yogurt cups  
Butter tubs  
Plastic food containers  
Steel cans  
Aluminum cans  
Aluminum foil & trays  
Metal jar lids


Clean & empty all liquids or  
solids. Ball aluminum foil.  
Keep plastic lids on. Labels  
are okay.

### Glass



Beverage bottles  
Sauce jars

Clean & empty all liquids or  
solids. Container glass only.  
No Pyrex or window panes.  
Metal lids go with mixed  
containers. Labels are okay.
