**BLIGHT REPORT FEB - MAR -2026**

**1) Again, this reporting period, I have been unable to meet with the TWP attorney. Several messages have been left and some returned but no follow up from him or his office. I did have an appointment made for March 27 at 10:30 through one of his office personnel, but Mr. Eppert did not show at his office, so I am not sure he even was aware of the meeting. I continue to try and contact him for advice and clarity of ticketing non-compliant properties in the TWP.**

**Once the correct procedure for enforcement is determined, I plan to put the procedure on the web site so all residents have an opportunity to see what will happen if properties get out of compliance. Also, I will put my contact information for complaints. UPDATE - I had a meeting scheduled for April 3rd that did not happen, but has been rescheduled for April 11. Will follow with April report.**

**2) Now that the weather is starting to clear, the snow is melting and folks are returning to their places in the TWP I plan to be more aggressive with non-compliance. There are several properties that I will be revisiting that have had several warnings and extensions of time to be compliant and these areas may be ticketed as laid out in the TWP ordinance. I will be working with the Sheriff when tickets are given.**

**3) The only communication I received this last two months was from the owner of the property at 1205 N. Sand Lake Rd.; He has assured mer that as the weather improves he will be either removing the cars from his driveway or getting plated and insured. The trailer and other debris in the driveway will be tarped until he can get the stuff to the dump or transfer station in town. I have been talking to him regularly and will continue a dialog until this property is in compliance.**
